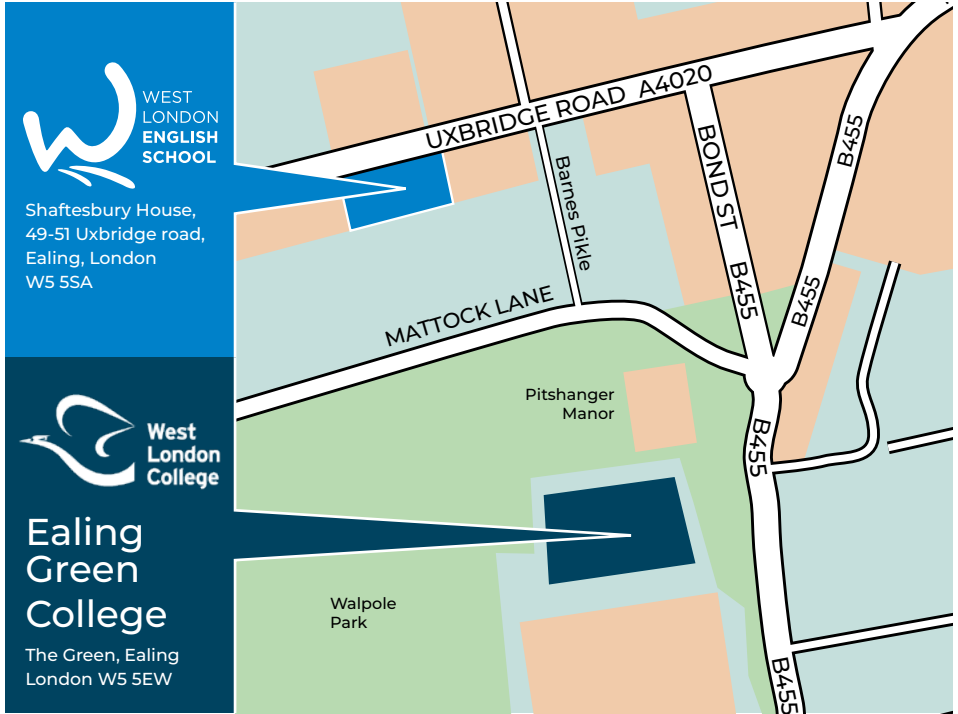
- Programmes can change because of weather conditions and other events (e.g. Tube strikes).

We understand the importance of comfortable accommodation. Our options for homestay host accommodation offer various options tailored to suit individual needs, ensuring a safe and convenient stay for students.

Our programme offers competitive pricing packages designed to provide value for money while delivering a high-quality educational experience.

Key information:

- **Age:** 12-17 years old
Students aged 11 must stay in accommodation provided by a family member or guardian.
- **Minimum age:** 12 years old
- Choose from half board or full board
- **Travel time:** up to 45 minutes by public transport from host family to the school
- **Meals:**
Half board (breakfast and dinner for 7 days)
Full board (breakfast, packed lunch and dinner for 7 days)

Under 18s Students Welfare and Safeguarding




At West London English School, we take our students' welfare and safety very seriously. We have a Safeguarding team who update and enforce our Safeguarding Policy. Please ask us if you would like to read this policy in full. All our staff are recruited with Safeguarding procedures in place, and receive regular training on how best to protect children.

All students on our Junior Programme are supervised by **at least one adult member of staff** throughout their stay with us, including during lessons, breaks*, afternoon activities*, and if under the age of 16, whenever they are in our homestay accommodation.
